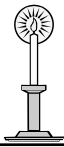

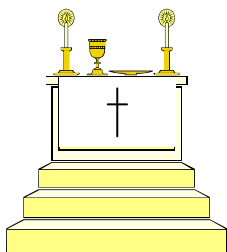

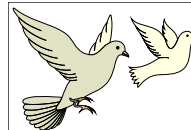

"Besa: The Promise"

North Shore Jewish Center is proud to present the film "Besa: The Promise", part of the 7th Annual Jewish Film Festival. The film is based on Norman Gershman's book "Besa" (Albanian for "Troth/Oath/Word of Honor"), how Albanians saved Jews during WWII. The National Endowment for the Humanities supported JM Productions in the making of the film.

Albania is a country of multi-religious society (with approx. 55% Christians, 20% Muslims, and 10% other religions), where Christianity (Catholicism, Orthodox Christians, Protestants) and other religions coexist in harmony for centuries.

Long-time fine art photographer Gershman spent five years collecting the stories of Albanians that happened to be of Muslim religion who sheltered and protected Jewish refugees during WWII, as part of the ancient interfaith national Albanian tradition of Besa, oath or word of honor given in this case to Jewish refugees for safe haven or sanctuary. Besa has its roots in the "Canon of Lek Dukagjini", a set of books of Canonical Albanian Law written by Lek Dukagjini, a Christian Catholic medieval northern Albanian Prince and Ruler and historical figure. Stony Brook University Library holds a copy of the "Canon of Lek Dukagjini".

Gershman record provides a clear and powerful example of best lasting mankind, human and moral values overcoming religious and ethnic divisions and violent extremism. The film tells his story and that of Rexhep Hoxha, an Albanian who must fulfill the word of honor and oath given to a Jewish family his father rescued during the Holocaust and return to them a set of Hebrew books they left behind.

After the film a native Albanian familiar with the story will be there to talk about the film and answer questions. Members of our local Muslim community have also been invited, to join our congregation in viewing this film.
