Epiphany Adult Christian Formation Program

Our Presiding Bishop Michael Curry said, "Racial justice will not change if we ignore it. We must confront it when we find it and one way to confront it is to have conversations about subjects that we would rather not engage." In order to help build on this conversation, our Diocesan Bishop Provenzano has asked all churches throughout the Diocese to hold multi-facet educational opportunities on Racism in our society. To this end, Caroline Church and All Souls' Church will hold a three evening program on Tuesdays at 7:00 p.m. beginning January 17 and continuing on January 24 and 31, in the Parish Library. We will reflect on the disparity of treatment in our country between various groups of people, look at systemic issues of injustice and how we may break free from them, as well as offer tangible theological reflection on ways we can deepen our resolve to pursue justice and mercy. All are invited to begin this Epiphany-tide time of reflection.
