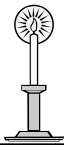

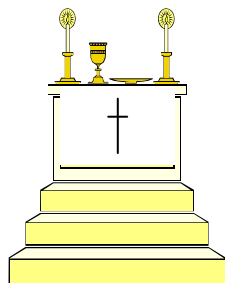

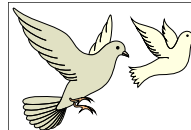

**Summer Children's Bible Story:** This year, instead of the usual Camp Caroline program for children, we will have a Children's Bible Story time in the Parish House during the 10:00 a.m. Sunday Holy Eucharist. Children will go with their volunteer Bible Story Teller during the Sermon time and return to Church during announcement time and participate in the remainder of our Holy Eucharist service with their families. There is a sign-up sheet for any adult or teen of whatever age to pick a Sunday to be a Caroline Bible Story Teller. Do be generous with your time.

## Culper Spy Day is July 23rd

The Historic and Cultural Artifacts Commission supervised a photo shoot within the church to be part of an interactive digital attraction celebrating the Culper Spy Ring. The Culper Spy Adventure is an interactive digital attraction that puts the participant in a starring role within the Culper spy mission. Accessed through any smartphone or tablet device, the journey begins by scanning a QR code on the Three Village map; travelling from historic location to location scenes come to life as the participant meets and interacts with some of our greatest local heroes: Caleb Brewster, Abraham Woodhull, Anna Smith-Strong, and more. Between each episode is an exciting interactive game.

The actors and production people were very respectful of our sanctuary and remarked effusively about the beauty of the Church.
