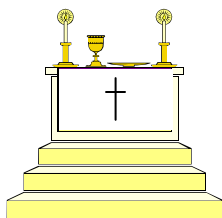

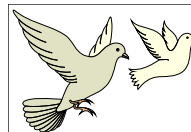

We will be **collating the Carillon** on Friday, **June 3rd** at 9:30am in the kitchen of the MCS building. Please come in through the back kitchen door.

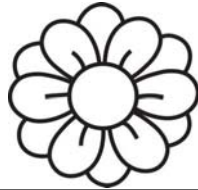

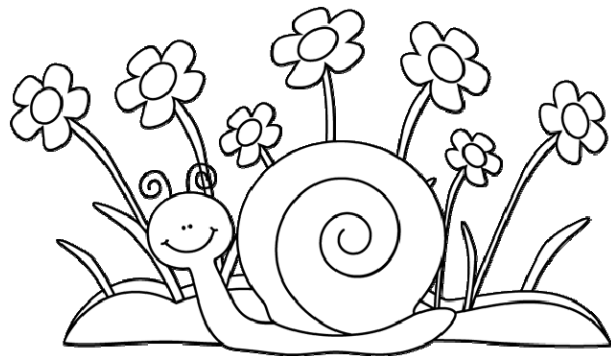

Summer Fair Raffle Baskets

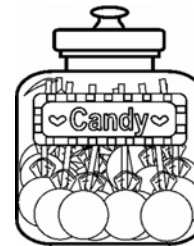
