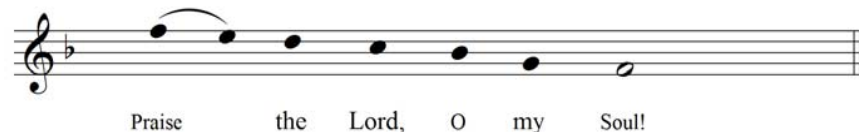
Annual Acolyte Recognition Day
