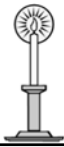

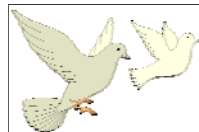

“Flu Shots will be available after services on **October 8**, 2017 for all over the age of 18, sponsored by the Brotherhood St. Andrew of Caroline Church. Shots will be given by Dr. Tyler Yarema, New York State licensed Pharmacist and immunization certified. Both regular quadrivalent and high dose quadrivalent, recommended for those over the age of 65, will be available.
